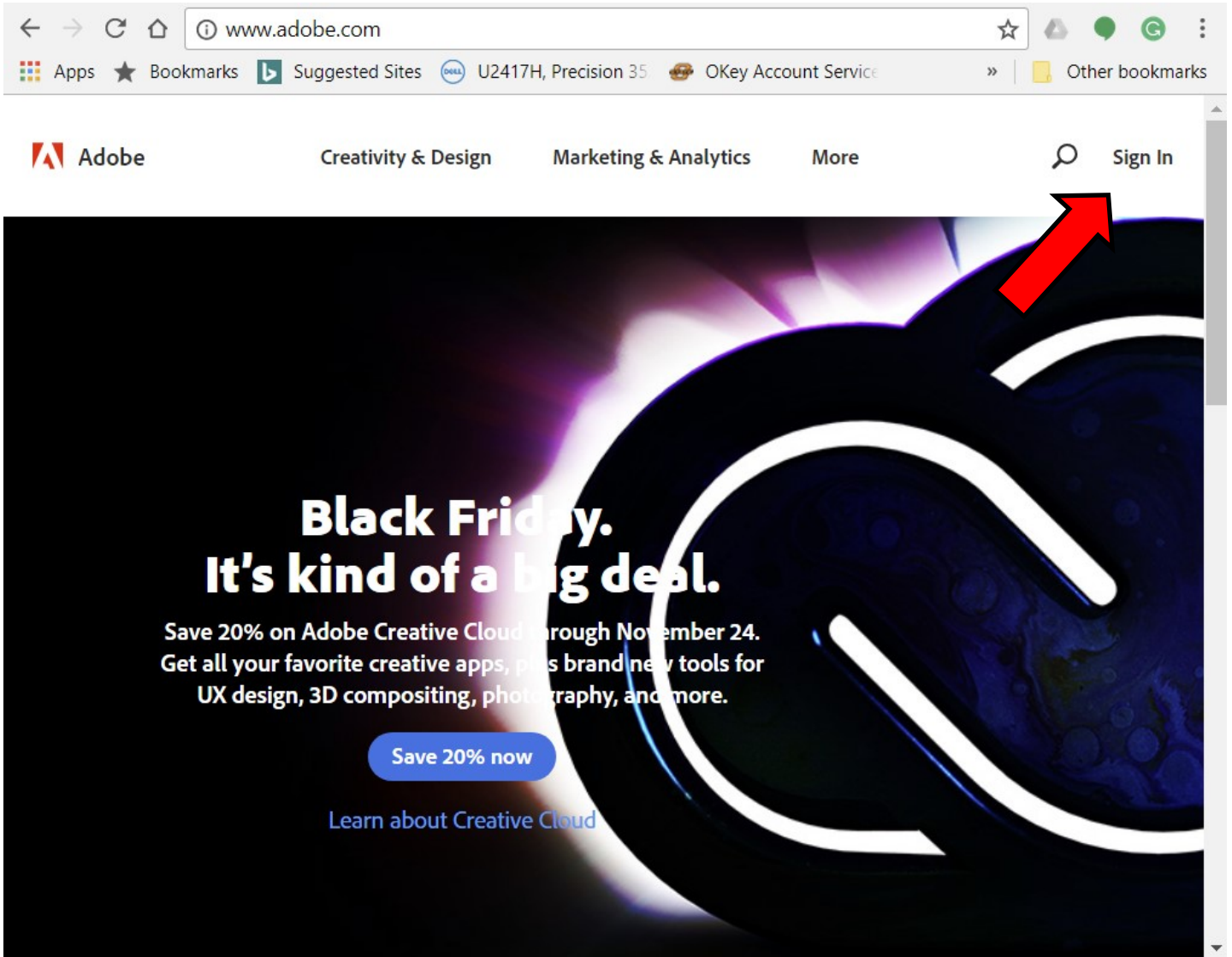


# Updating Adobe software using Adobe Creative Cloud.

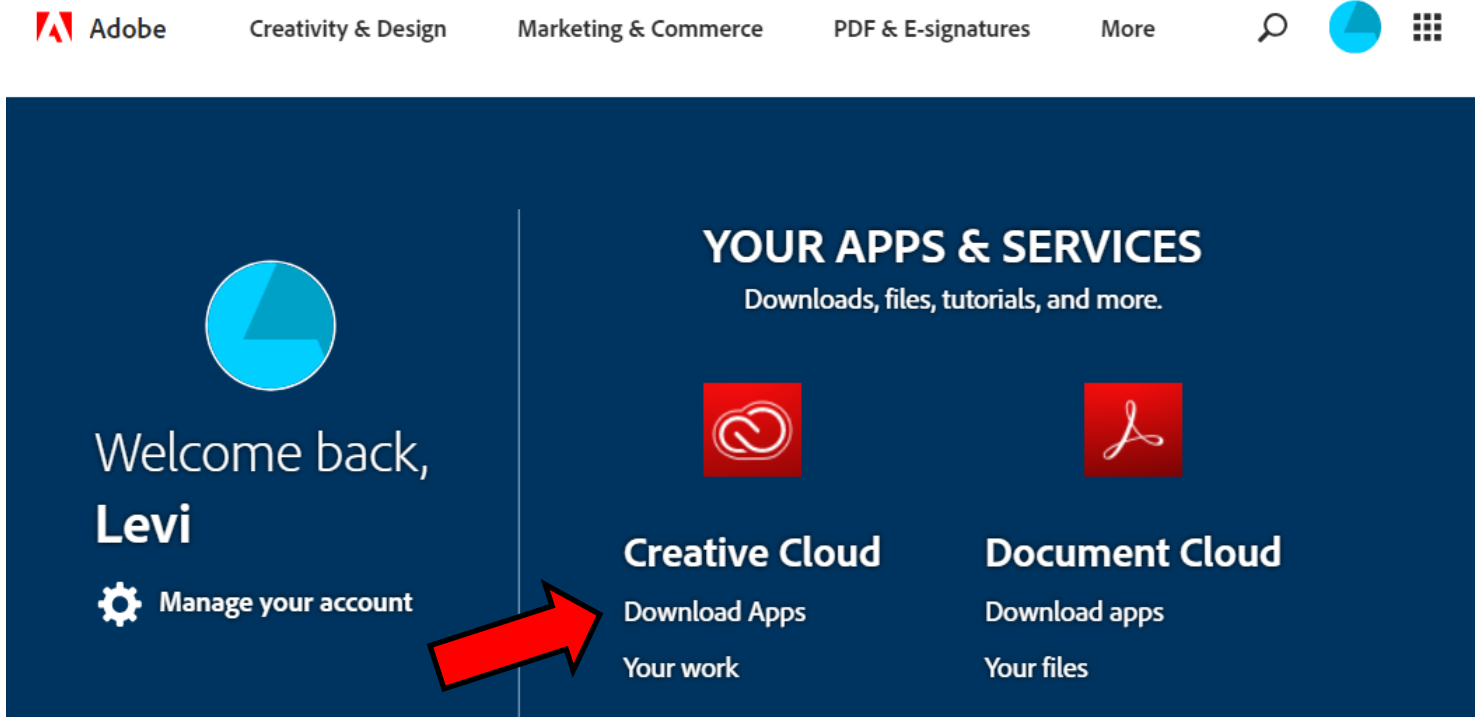
1. Open an internet browser and navigate to [Adobe.com](https://www.adobe.com).
2. Click the Sign In button at the top right of the screen.



3. Enter your O-Key email address and tab or click on the password field. (if asked choose Enterprise ID.)
4. This will redirect you to the O-Key login page.
5. Enter your O-Key email address and password.

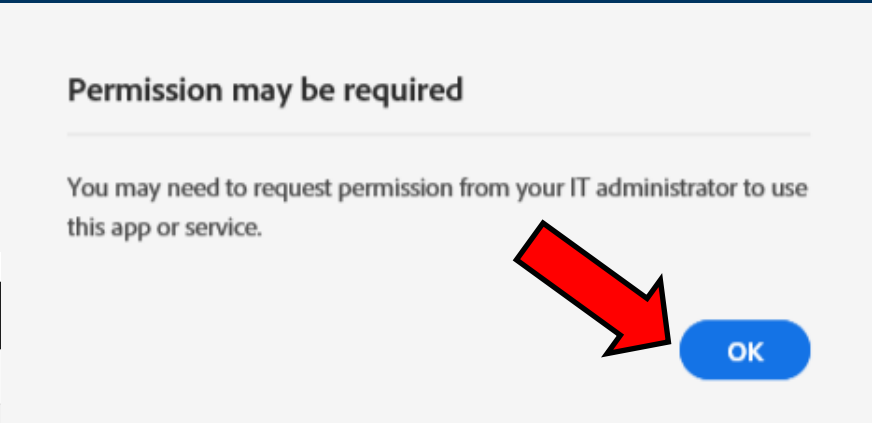
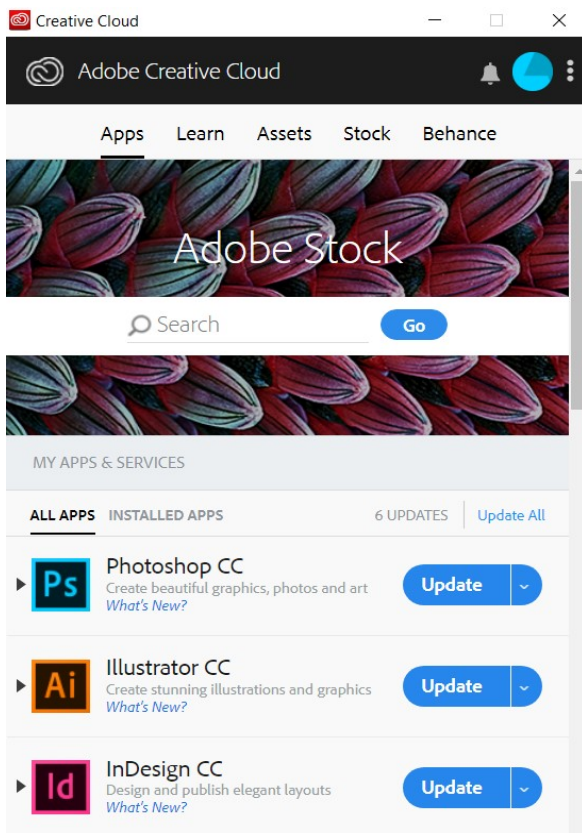

6. After you are logged in, choose the Download Apps link under the Creative Cloud heading (shown below.)



7. Scroll down the page to the Desktop apps section.

8. Click Download the first app that you would like to install



9. Click ok (image above.)

10. Click Run after the download finishes.

11. After the installer finishes, you should be able to open the program.

12. If you would like other Adobe programs installed. Look for creative cloud in your all programs list.

13. All other programs can be installed from the Apps section in Adobe Creative Cloud. (image to the left.)
