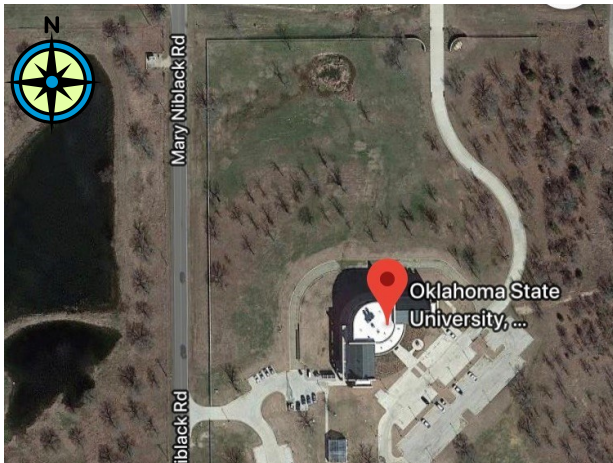

Introduction

This is a 1-day turfgrass and landscape management workshop. It is designed to benefit turfgrass and landscape managers in lawn, parks, grounds, athletic field and golf course care. The course emphasizes sound research-based fundamentals in turf and landscape management for Oklahoma. Topics covered include diagnosing tree problems, spray nozzle selection, proper adjuvant use, turf/row weed id, turf-tree-ornamental pest management and managing turf in shade.

This course is a cooperative effort among the county, area and state extension educators of the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service of Oklahoma State University. This course is provided as an education opportunity to further professional career development and technical knowledge of attendees.
