

Adobe Sign Signatory Instructions

(non-lead PI/Co-PI, Department Head, Associate Dean, Departmental Financial Staff, any other required signature)

**Note – The signatory process can be completed on any device (desktop computer, laptop, tablet, or phone) that has an internet connection. No login, account, or password is required to sign a document.*

- 1.) The Signer will receive an email from Adobe Sign. There is a link in the email.

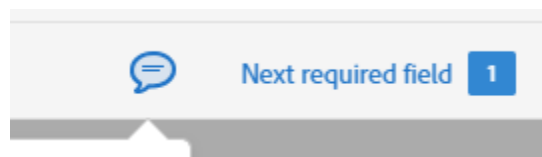

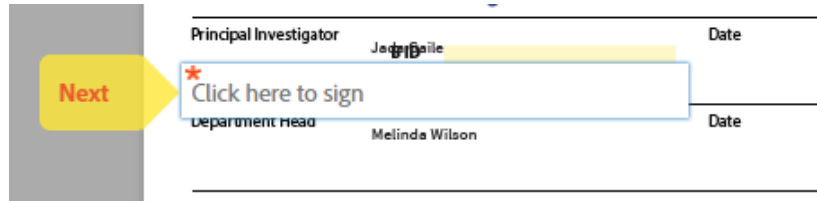

- 2.) The Signer will be directed to Adobe Sign. To sign the document, you do not have to be logged into Adobe Sign.
- 3.) As a required signer, you should review **all** of the documents in the routing package.
- 4.) Unless instructed otherwise, you do not need to complete any other field(s) in the routing form(s).
- 5.) Once you have reviewed the documents, click “Next required Field”.

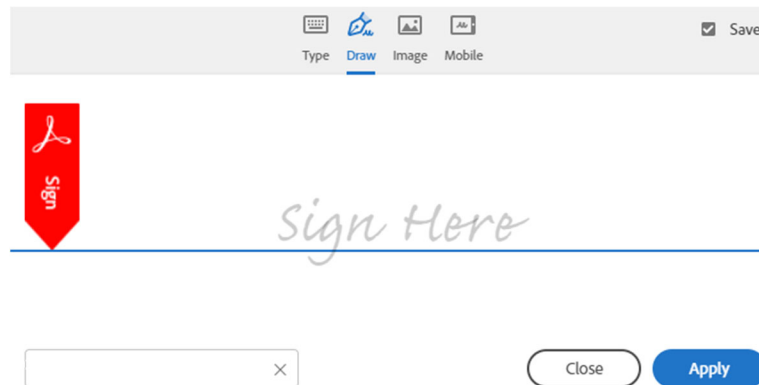


6.) You will be directed to the place(s) you need to sign.

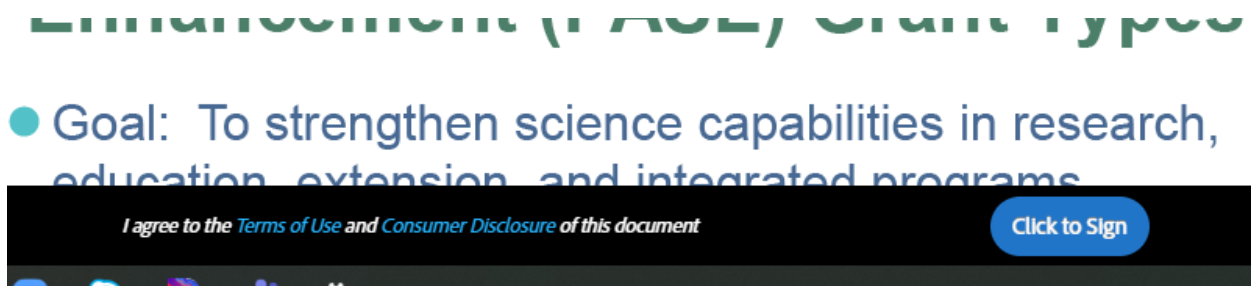


7.) Clicking in the box, will bring up the signature dialog box. There are multiple ways to sign. By clicking the "Save" Box, your signature will be automatically prompted the next time a signature is requested.

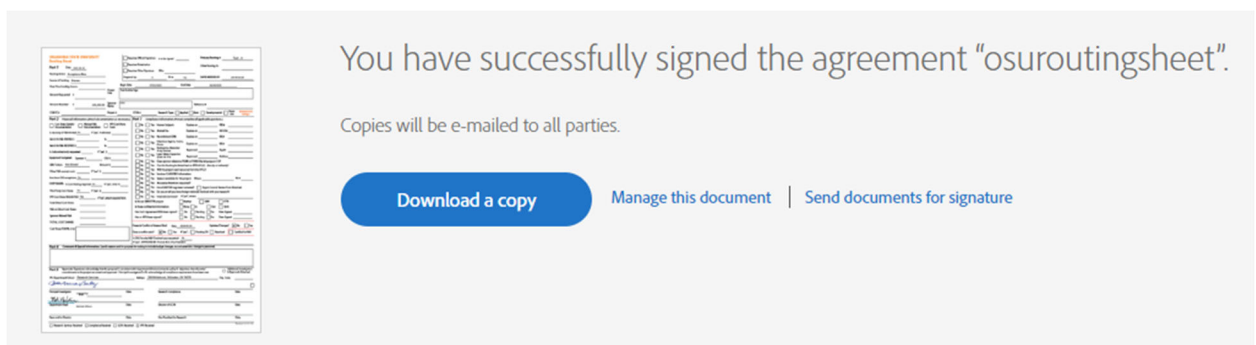
- a. Type
- b. Draw
- c. Image (You can upload a picture of your signature by logging into your Adobe Cloud Profile using your Okey Login information, selecting Enterprise ID Account, and going to "My Signature." https://na2.documents.adobe.com/account/accountSettingsPage#pageId::MY_SIGNATURE)
- d. Mobile – Enter your mobile phone number and you will be sent a link via your device.



8.) Once all the required signature fields have been completed, a status bar will pop up at the bottom of the document. "Click to sign" to complete the document.

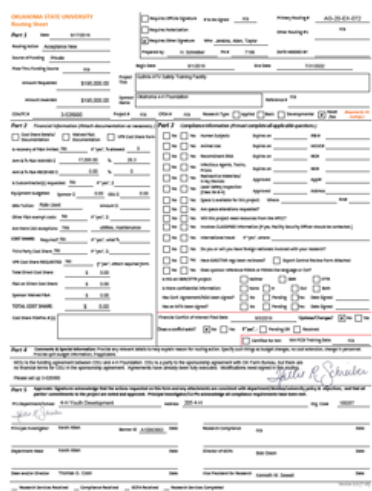


9.) You will then have an option to Download a copy or manage the document. An email will be sent to all signatories when the document has been completed.



If you need to delegate signature, there are three ways to delegate: (Note: Since this process can be done from any internet-connected device, delegation should be done only in extenuating circumstances)

- 1.) From within the original email. Click the link and enter the email address of the person you wish to sign as your delegate. You should enter an explanation in the message box. This delegates signature for THIS ROUTING PACKAGE only and will not affect future routing packages.

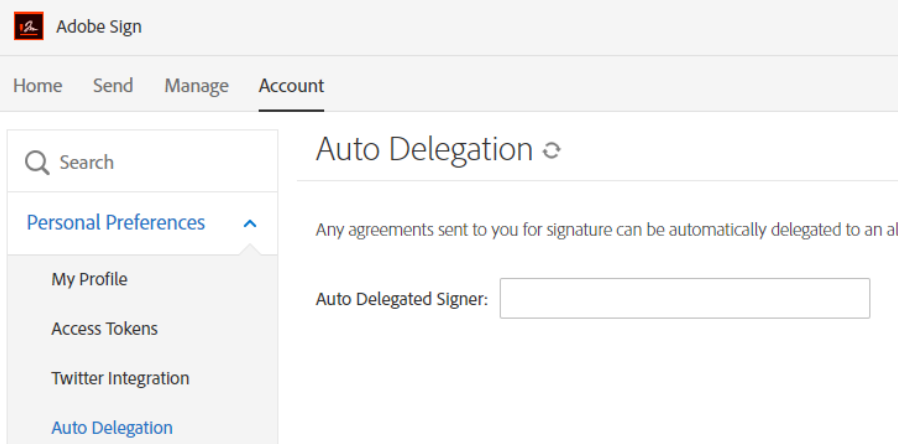

- 2.) From your Adobe Sign account. For this option, you must login to Adobe Sign. This delegation stays in place for all Adobe Sign packages, until it is removed from your account.



- 3.) By notifying the Sponsored Programs staff member that originated the routing package. The originator of any package can replace the current signer.

Note: Any delegation means the original signer will not receive any notifications of the status of the document and will not be able to see the document in their Adobe Sign dashboard.
